

Milland Recreation Ground – Charity no. 1073462

Aims & activities

The charity manages and maintains the recreation ground for the benefit of the inhabitants of the parish and for the provision of such ancillary facilities. The facilities include a five-a-side basketball unit, an adventure play area, two bay swings, a junior play area and two pay and play tennis courts. Activities held include the annual bonfire night and the bi annual rural fair.

Charitable objects

For the benefit of the inhabitants of the Parish of Iping and the neighbourhood thereof and for the provision thereon of such ancillary facilities for the benefit of the said inhabitants as the council may from time to time think fit.
